POSITIONS AVAILABLE

EXECUTIVE

- **You must have actively participated in SGA during the previous school year to hold an executive position.**
- President: Open to Seniors only.
 - The President oversees SGA. He or she must be willing to guide meetings, delegate tasks, and ensure the overall smooth-running of the association.
- Vice-President: Open to Juniors and Seniors.
 - The Vice-President makes posts on social media and informs members when there is a meeting. He or she fills in whenever the President and/or the Secretary/Treasurer are not present.
- Secretary/Treasurer: Open to Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors.
 - The Secretary/Treasurer records attendance and keeps track of membership.

CLASS

- President
 - The President oversees his or her class' role in SGA. He or she must be willing to guide class meetings and delegate tasks.
- Vice-President
 - The Vice-President makes posts on social media and informs members when there is a meeting. He or she fills in whenever the President and/or the Secretary/Treasurer are not present.
- Secretary/Treasurer
 - The Secretary/Treasurer records attendance of the class meetings.
- Homeroom Representatives
 - Homeroom Representatives are active members of the SGA. They have voting rights and are involved in the planning and execution of SGA sponsored activities and events.
 - Each Homeroom will elect a class representative IF there is a student willing to participate.

CAMPAIGN GUIDELINES

- All candidates must attend a meeting Thursday, August 29, before school from 7:30-7:45am OR after school from 2:45-3:00pm to go over campaign guidelines. The meeting will be held in Ms. Houts' Room, Building 200-201.
- Candidates may start their campaigns August 30.

POSTERS

- Candidates are required to display between 3-5 posters in the cafeteria. Other posters/handouts are optional. **YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE REMOVAL OF ALL CAMPAIGN MATERIALS.**
- Posters must be hung using painter's tape.
- Posters must be in good taste and fitting with the expectations of the Crystal River High School community.

TELEVISED INTERVIEW – ALL CANDIDATES EXCEPT HOMEROOM REPRESENTATIVES

- Candidates may choose to sit for a 20 to 30-second prerecorded video which will be aired during homeroom before voting occurs September 5. (This is optional. If you want to participate, please follow instructions carefully!)
- Write a **20-second script** answering **ONLY** the following questions in a WORD document, and **save it to a jump drive**. **PRACTICE** your speech. It can be **NO MORE** than 30 seconds long.
- Include **ONLY** the following in your speech:
 - What is your name and what position are you running for?
 - Why have you chosen to run for this position?
 - What do you feel you have to offer SGA?
 - What is the best part about Crystal River High School?
 - Do you have anything else that you would like everyone to know before they vote?
- **Bring the Jump Drive** to the TV Production room in the business hallway (behind the library) during **FIRST** or **SECOND** block **ONLY** on August 30 (Friday), September 3 (Tuesday), or September 4 (Wednesday). ****Get permission** from your teacher to go, and make sure he or she knows this will take appx. 15 minutes.
- TV Production will load your script on the teleprompter and you will record your short campaign speech at that time.

HOMEROOM REPRESENTATIVE CANDIDATES

- Homeroom Representative Candidates will have the opportunity to give a 30-second prepared speech during homeroom before voting on September 5. (This is optional. If you choose to participate, please follow instructions carefully!)
- Write a **20 to 30-second script** answering **ONLY** the following questions. It can be **NO MORE** than 30 seconds long. Be prepared to deliver this speech during homeroom September 5.
- Include **ONLY** the following in your speech:
 - What is your name and what position are you running for?
 - Why have you chosen to run for this position?
 - What do you feel you have to offer SGA?
 - What is the best part about Crystal River High School?
 - Do you have anything else that you would like everyone to know before they vote?
